FROM THE PRINCIPAL:

The Rosary Prayer Service was a wonderful experience this school year as it was last. It took place on Tuesday, 7 October, the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. The feast commemorates the victory of the Holy League at the Battle of Lepanto on October 7, 1571. That victory was attributed to the Blessed Virgin by Pope Pius V, through the collective prayer of the rosary. The whole month of October is time to devote to praying the rosary. We hope our families consider taking an evening or two and praying the rosary together. Thank you to our seniors for leading us in prayer this past Tuesday.

Next week on Friday, October 17, there is a day off school for our Faculty/Staff Retreat Day. It's a time for VASJ's faculty and staff members to pray and reflect on the school year so far and the months and activities ahead.

FROM THE DEAN OF ACADEMICS:

Our first quarter of school is quickly approaching. It ends on Friday, October 24. Please make sure you are logging into PowerSchool and checking your students progress daily. Report cards will be out by the end of the following week.

Ineligibility for the quarter will be determined by October 31 and communicated to the Athletic Director and club moderators. A student will be deemed ineligible for the entire second quarter if their grade point average is below 1.7 or if the student is not passing five (5) one credit classes or equivalent. Any ineligible student will not be able to participate in any sporting contests or in any activities that occur during the school day.

On Thursday, October 23, the WHOLE school will be attending the Bishops Mass & Rally at Cleveland Public Auditorium. This will NOT be a late start day. All students are to be in full dress uniform and in the building by 7:45 a.m. Students will have an early dismissal at 2:00 p.m. that day. Think of this as a whole school field trip.

FROM THE DEAN OF STUDENTS:

As Halloween approaches, it is imperative to engage in discussions with your students regarding the prohibition of wearing masks or Halloween makeup on school premises. Notably, young children will be present at our annually scheduled "Halloween On Campus" event, where our seniors participate in costume-based activities to entertain and collaborate with our young ghouls and goblin guests.

It is crucial to emphasize that ONLY SENIORS are permitted to dress up for this day, as it constitutes a community service obligation and a rite of passage for our students. Furthermore, preventing the entire school from wearing costumes and masks serves as a safety measure, enabling faculty, staff, and administrators to readily identify your child without any ambiguity. Students who decide to disobey this policy will face strict penalties that may include suspension.

Lastly, Have you noticed a sweet smell coming from your child's room or person? Chances are, they are not baking cupcakes but may be in possession of a tobacco vape. The use of an e-cigarette is often referred to as "vaping." An electronic cigarette, or e-cigarette, that comes in a variety of sizes and shapes, has a liquid substance to heat, a place to hold the liquid, and a battery. Some e-cigarettes look like pipes or cigars while others may look like USB sticks and tubes known as pens. These devices have no place in our school and I'm sure you would agree that they have no place in your child's room, pocket or purse. In a proactive effort to foster a drug-free learning environment, we are pleased to announce the hosting of a Vape Prevention Event for students and parents.
