FROM THE DEAN OF ACADEMICS:

Happy Friday!

November is moving by so quickly. Although the weather has been somewhat cooperative, the holidays are quickly approaching. We only have 18 academic days until semester exams in December!! Here are a few reminders:

- December 5 is the sophomore retreat. Sophomores only are allowed to wear jeans (no holes) or joggers and a Viking shirt or a solid red or blue top and tennis shoes. No Hoodies, Crocs, sandles or open toed shoes.
- We do have school on Monday and Tuesday before Thanksgiving break. These are regular school days and students should be in attendance.
- Final exams are December 16-18 with the Make-Up day for excused absences is on Friday, December 19. **These are mandatory attendance days.**
- Christmas break starts on Friday, December 19 and students return on Monday, January 5, 2026.

Information regarding semester exams will be published just after Thanksgiving break. These are short days. Students will take a maximum of two tests per day, unless they have two math classes. **Breakfast will be served in the morning, but there will be NO lunch service.** Testing will be done prior to noon, so please make transportation plans for your student accordingly. Van transportation will adjust their schedule for drop-off after exams.

Please continue to check PowerSchool for your student's academic progress. Tutoring is available every week, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 3:15 p.m. - 4:00 pm. If you have questions or concerns, please contact the teacher directly for clarification.

FROM THE DEAN OF STUDENTS:

On December 1, all students must meet school standards regarding hair color. Any Student arriving at school on December 1 with an **Unnatural hair color, including but not limited to: blue, green, yellow, pink, purple, & bright red** will be sent home and will not be permitted to return until the hair color issue has been rectified. **THIS POLICY WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.** It is supported by all administrators of VASJ and the

Cleveland Catholic Diocese.

All students are expected to wear their full uniforms and possess all necessary items to meet our personal appearance policy outlined in our Parent/Student Handbook. Male students are required to wear belts and ensure their pants are not sagging. Ties must be worn daily and pulled up to the neck, not loose and may not be obscured by a sweater or sweatshirt. Shirts must be long enough to tuck them into pants without the shirt becoming untucked. This policy applies to the ladies as well; shirts must be tucked in, skirts must not be altered or fixed to appear shorter, tights must be worn, and leggings are prohibited. Shoes must conform to the dress code requirements outlined in the student

handbook (NO CROCS, TENNIS SHOES, OPEN-TOED SHOES, OR SLIDES).

Please be advised that the administration will no longer issue warnings regarding dress code violations.

Students will receive disciplinary action for these infractions, which may include suspension. Students have until December 1 to obtain the necessary items to address this issue. THIS SERVES AS A FINAL WARNING TO ALL.
