FROM THE DEAN OF ACADEMICS:

Happy Holidays!!

Christmas break is upon us, and the students are ready for some rest after exams. We will return to school on Monday, January 5, 2026. That will only be a four day week for the students, as Friday, is a teacher In-Service day. That Friday, January 9, 2026 is also the official end of both quarter 2 and Semester 1. For students who have one semester courses, like physical education or Technology, they will finish the semester the week we return.

Grades will be finalized for the second quarter and first semester by many teachers the week we return. Much of the work that week will go on to the third quarter grading period. Teachers will finalize grades, and then we will determine eligibility and award credit. Eligibility is based on the second quarter grades. Credit is awarded by the semester for coursework with passing grades. However, if a student fails a semester of a course, and that course is required for graduation, the student will be required to attend summer school to recover the credit. Parents will be notified if a student will need to attend summer school.

Report cards will be **EMAILED** to parents/guardians with a secure link no later than Friday, January 16, 2026. Please take a moment to ensure all of your correct contact information is updated in FinalForms. If not, you may not be receiving all the school communications, including report card reports.

For our seniors, the New Year brings with it the realization that they are nearing the end of their high school career. This causes both joy and anxiety, and can also instill the dreaded 'senioritis' for students. Although it will be 2026, there will still be a great deal of work to be done before graduation day, so please help us keep your student focused on finishing their senior year well. After the start of the year, we will be sending out information to senior families with all the senior events and dates.

HAPPENINGS IN THE VILLAGE

FROM THE COUNSELING OFFICE: COPING WITH THE HOLIDAYS (part 3)

TEENS AND THE HOLIDAYS: The holiday season can stress for teens as well as adults and not all teens respond to stress in the same way. Watch for behavior changes in your child. Some common changes to watch for include:

- Excessive crying or irritation
- Excessive worry or sadness
- Returning to behaviors they've outgrown
- "Acting out" behaviors
- Poor school performance; avoiding school
- Avoidance of activities enjoyed in the past.
- Unexplained headaches or body pain
- Unhealthy eating or sleeping habits

- Difficulty with attention and concentration
- Use of alcohol, tobacco or other drugs

TIPS TO SUPPORT TEENS DURING THE HOLIDAYS:

Manage your own stress.

Kids react, in part, to what they see from the adults around them. When parents and caregivers deal with the holidays calmly and confidently, they can provide the best support for their children. Be a role model. Connect with others, take breaks, get enough sleep, exercise and eat well.

Keep your routines (as best you can).

Manage expectations.

Be up front and let kids know what they can and can't expect over the holidays.

Talk to them.

Be honest, focus on the positive and give them space for their feelings. Be available to talk and answer questions they may have.

Reassurance and resilience.

Reassure kids that everything will be ok even if things don't go as planned. Share with them how you deal with stress so that they can learn from you how to cope with stress.

Spend time together.

Real time where you are sharing an activity that involves interaction. Play games together, bake cookies, have a dance party, read together, etc.

Create a new holiday tradition.

Make homemade gifts or decorations and create things you can do together every year that are meaningful and fun. Get teens involved in helping others. Donate to a toy drive, deliver a note to a neighbor or call or write to a family member.

COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS INFORMATION MEETING: On Wednesday, January 28, 2026, we will be hosting our annual College Credit Plus Night for the 2026-2027 school year. It will be held in the Founders Chapel from 6:00 p.m.-8:00 p.m. College Credit Plus (CCP) is Ohio's dual credit program where students can earn high school and college credit simultaneously by taking courses at participating Ohio colleges and universities tuition free.

The CCP informational evening is for parents and students in grades 9-11 who are interested in or plan to participate in the College Credit Plus program for the 2026-2027 school year. In the meantime, get a head start and review these important reminders that can also be found on the Ohio Department of Education website:

- 1. Interested students should have at least a 2.75-3.0 GPA
- 2. Apply to the college(s) of your choice under College Credit Plus now. A college admission letter is needed!
- 3. Create an OH/ID account to apply for Ohio State CCP funding anytime between February 1- April 1.
- 4. Receive your funding award letter and register for college classes
