Spirit Week We have truly enjoyed being a part of the excitement Spirit Week tends to bring.

Homecoming Game: We are excited for our homecoming game this evening. I'd like to remind our students and parents to maintain a respectful attitude towards our guests, referees, police officers, and staff members who are diligently overseeing the event.

Students are required to occupy their designated student section and refrain from congregating under or behind the stands. Failure to comply with this directive may result in their removal from the stands and escort off our school premises. Students and guests who exhibit disruptive behavior will be promptly removed from the event and escorted out. Any VASJ students who are removed from the game may face further disciplinary action.

Homecoming Dance: This formal event has a strict dress code. Please review the following guidelines that were included on the homecoming contract you signed.

- Gentlemen attendees are expected to wear dress pants, dress shirt, coat/sweater (optional), tie (optional) and dress shoes. NO JEANS, TENNIS SHOES, CROCS, POLO SHIRTS OR CASUAL CLOTHING.
- The Ladies are expected to wear dresses or pantsuits. Dresses must be fingertip length, no higher than 3 inches above the knee, or longer. Dresses should be appropriately loose. NO cut-outs! Front bodice and waist must be completely covered with opaque material, no sheer material, no low cut/cleavage, and open back no farther down than the natural waist. The dress MUST fully cover a lady's sides and MUST have a modest neckline.

All students and their guests must adhere to the dress code. Failure to do so will result in the imposition of a call home to either collect you or provide you with appropriate attire with a possible ISS.

College Now can assist you and your student with the following:

- Completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the CSS Profile (if required)
- Exploring available financial aid resources for college, including scholarships, loans, work-study, and private funding
- Interpreting and comparing financial aid award letters
- Recommending students for scholarships administered by College Now (requires Pell-Grant eligibility and specific GPA and ACT/SAT test score guidelines)

To schedule an appointment, go to the electronic sign up at https://cngc.org/VASJ-CNGC. This will bring you to the Bookings scheduling page. (Follow the directions on the other side of this handout to schedule your College Now appointment on Bookings.) In the event of a school closure, College Now appointments will be held by phone or through a virtual meeting. You will be contacted via the email or cell number you provided during sign up if your appointment is adjusted in any way.

PARKING PERMITS: Beginning October 1st, any student car parked without a permit will be towed at the owner's expense. The cost of the parking permit is \$50.00 and can be paid with cash, check or credit card. Students are to see Mrs. Taraska in the Principal's Office for a permit request form for a parent to complete. Once they return the completed form with payment, they will receive their permit and parking spot. Spots are still available.
