Treasurer's Report – There are no outstanding checks. The end-of-year-balance from the bank statement and internal ledger is \$21,339.30. This figure will be used for our IRS reporting. Copies of the internal ledger, concessions ledger, and concessions work sheet were presented.

President's Comments – Presented by Jim Tobin for Tom Carone: The new bleachers and press box have been installed and associated contractor work should be completed by the end of this week. Preliminary work on the stage and gym floor will be delayed. A three-quote process is active and will take more time than was anticipated.

AD's Comments – Not present. A request was made from the floor that going forward the AD, the Assistant AD, or a designated representative should attend all Oarsmen meetings. The Oarsmen Club exists to support the school's athletic program and needs counsel from the Athletic Department.

Chuck and Juli will be reaching out to all the athletic teams prior to the February Meeting (2/28/26) to get a team representative to attend. Also, we will be sharing our Oarsmen Mission with them.

Concession Stand Committee – Scheduling is going well. All games are covered by teams and clubs.

Old Business:

1. Superbowl squares \$100. 45 tickets have been sold as of today. Let's try to get more parents to participate by going to social media/website/parent newsletter before we ask our friends/alumni contacts. We want to communicate what we are going to do with the potential \$4,000. We'd like to spruce up the lobby. Open a contest for 6 or 8 4' x 5' pictures and vote on them.
2. The parents' social event will be at Collision Bend on February 27th.
3. We are still looking to get sports team representation at meetings.
4. The cost of the film room chairs (\$1,875) was cared for by the Oarsmen. The chairs were purchased and installed in December.
5. The old AD office near the weight room is being converted into a utility/2nd film room/etc.

New Business:

1. Track will be hosting a home track meet on Friday May 8th, a full-blown meet under the lights. Coach Wright will use this as an occasion to recognize retired Coaches Ken Prince and Chuck Martinko. More to follow.
2. Baseball will be hosting a Reverse Raffle on Saturday, March 21 in the Gym.
3. The Oarsmen will host the annual Clambake on Saturday October 10. The date was selected after reviewing the football schedule. Fred Mastalski has volunteered to chair the planning efforts and will be assisted by Ron Banc. More to follow.

4. The Viking Golf Outing will be hosted by the Oarsmen Club and will be held at Briardale Greens on Friday, July 24th. Juli Gembus has volunteered to chair this event. Proceeds will be distributed to teams that work and support the event.
5. The Oarsmen plan to host a Teacher Appreciation reception in the VA Heritage Center on Friday, February 20, a pregame event to coincide with the Boys' Basketball Senior Night. Appetizers and soft drinks will be provided. More to follow.
