In Readers Workshop, we are now learning about kings and queens. This unit has both fiction and nonfiction stories! In Writers Workshop, we have continued writing words and sentences on our own. Please practice writing at home when you can. In Guided Reading, we have learned all letters and have moved from reading just CVC words to words with consonant blends ("fr" in "frog"). I also sent home short stories that your child should be able to read on their own. Please practice these stories as well as sight words! Having finished learning about the United States as a whole, we have moved onto maps! We know what a map tells us and we just learned about map keys and compass roses. We will also learn about globes, landforms, and bodies of water in the coming weeks.
