
\*\*Your goal should be to read every night for pleasure.

#### Information for Parents:

Five Finger Rule

Ask your child to read a random page. Count the number of times your child stumbles over or misses a word without self-correction. If you count more than five misses on a page, that book may be too challenging or your child may need adult assistance to read.



#### Academic Review:

\*\*It is suggested that any work not completed in your Kindergarten books be completed over the summer for reinforcement of skills and concepts.

All current SHS students should continue working on Kindergarten curriculum on IXL.

The goal is to have a medal in all of the Kindergarten skills by

September.

\*\*Be sure to review your math skills - specifically number recognition up to 100, single digit addition, and single digit subtraction.

\*\*You MUST be able to recognize and count up to 50.
