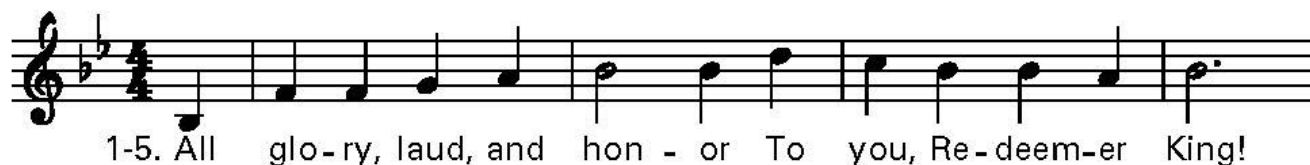

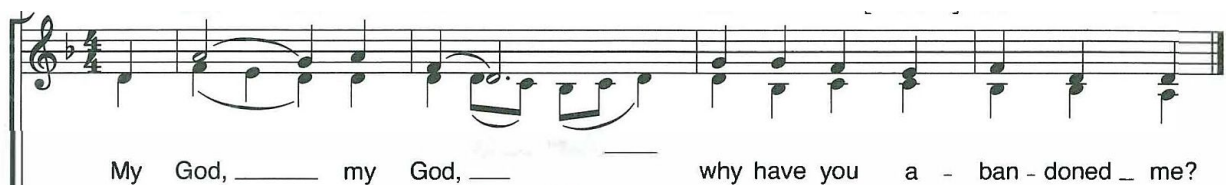
A reading from the Book of the Prophet Isaiah

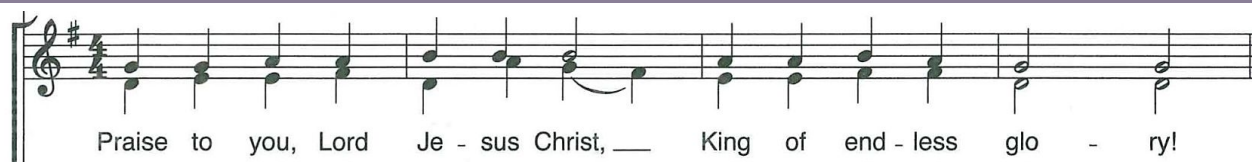
Second Reading
