The Prayer to Saint Michael

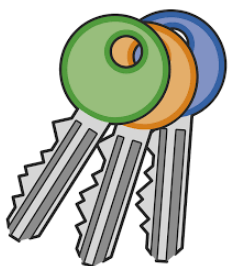

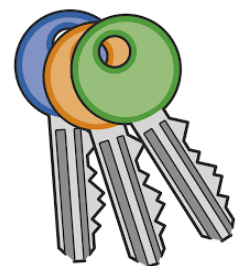
