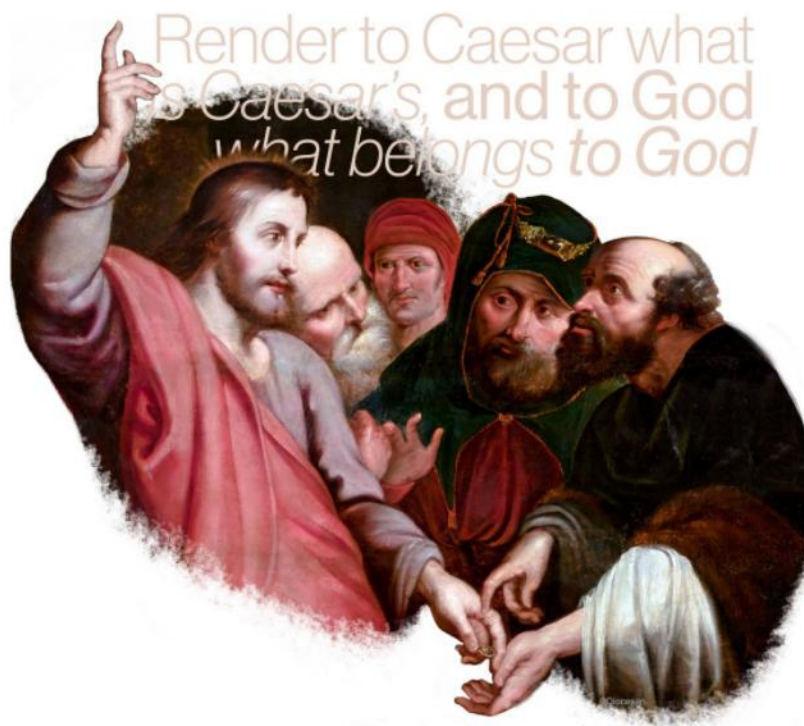


## Gospel Reading

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Matthew

The Pharisees went off and plotted how they might entrap Jesus in speech.
