The Office of the Clerk of Civil District Court would like to invite seniors in our community to join them at one of their Senior Summer Tours.

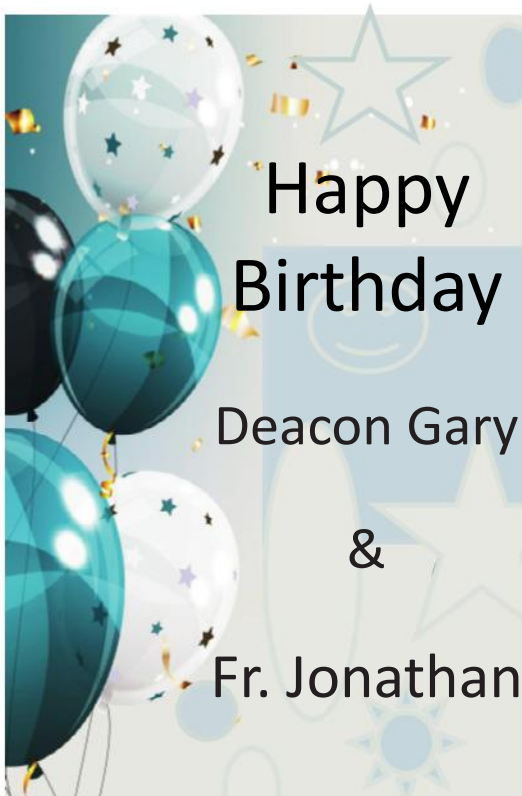
