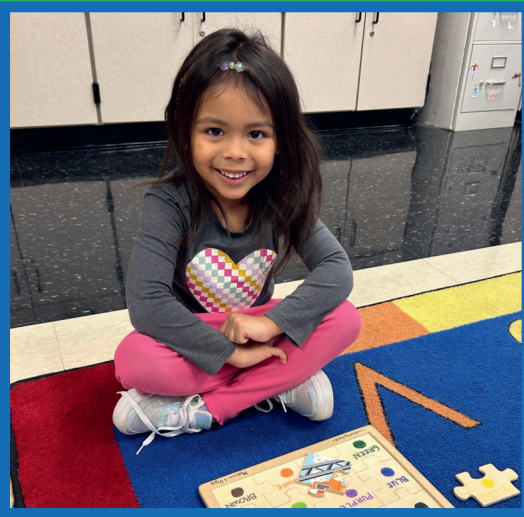
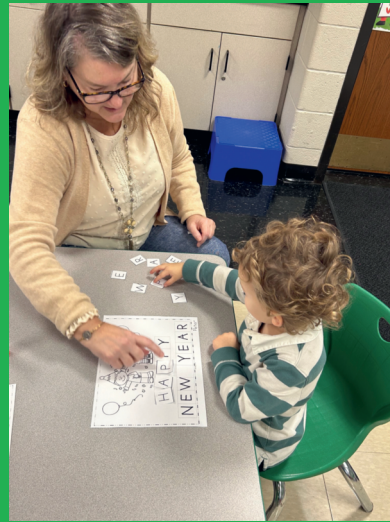


## About Our Faith

While preparing the children academically we believe that the faith formation and development is the key to our program. Religion permeates everything we do and all that we are. Also, students are active in stewardship in our community.

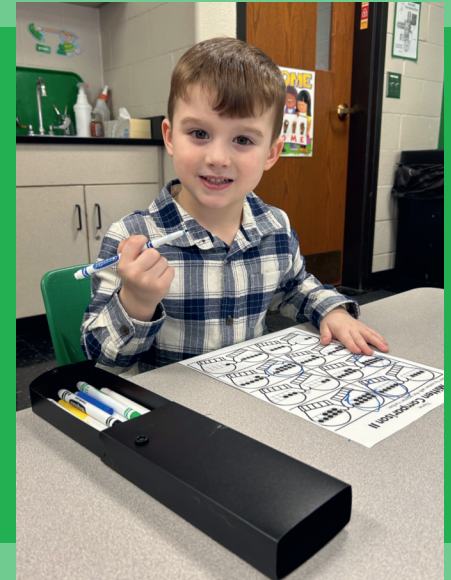
