Included in your folder are a variety of documents that will provide information about our school and information necessary to start the enrollment process online. Please be aware of the following items:

- If you are paying in-parish tuition rates, you must be a registered member of our parish. If this is not the case, please stop by the Church Office to register during their regular hours. (M-F 8:30-4:00)
- We must have State Birth Certificates (not the one issued by the hospital) and Baptismal Certificates before any enrollment is considered complete. Please do not turn in the paperwork until you have all of those documents available.
- The enrollment fee is \$200 per student, which covers the cost of textbooks and supplies. There is also a \$140 technology/STEM fee per student. The technology fee supports our existing technology plan and allows for maintenance and upgrades to our current system. The STEM fee will be used to purchase supplies for our STEM program. The total for one child is \$340, \$680 for two children, \$1,020 for three children, or \$1,360 for four children. The Enrollment Fee is non-refundable.
- You must complete an application online through FACTS. Once the office has reviewed your application, you will receive an email to complete the enrollment process. If more information is needed, the office will contact you.
- If you are enrolling a student, please note the additional requirements. New students will fill out a new student contract during the online enrollment process.
- If possible, Kindergarteners should attend Kindergarten Round-up on Thursday, April 9th, 2026.

2026-2027 TUITION AND ENROLLMENT/ TECHNOLOGY FEES

To qualify for in-parish tuition rates, families are required to be active and contributing parishioners. The parish asks for a minimum of \$1,000 contribution annually for school and church operations. Please keep in mind this is a minimum. However, to maintain the quality of our education programs, we count on families giving as close as possible to the actual cost of educating each child, which is \$7,660. Please prayerfully consider this as you decide upon your annual gift to the church.

ENROLLMENT AND TECHNOLOGY/STEM FEES

Enrollment fee & Technology/STEM fees are NOT applied to tuition.

The enrollment fee is \$200 per student and covers textbooks and classroom supplies. The technology and STEM fee is \$140 per student and supports our technology plan, including system maintenance and upgrades. Your child's enrollment is not finalized until you submit all required fees and complete all online forms. Fees are non-refundable. If you have questions, please contact the school office. Fees are due by February 9, 2026.
