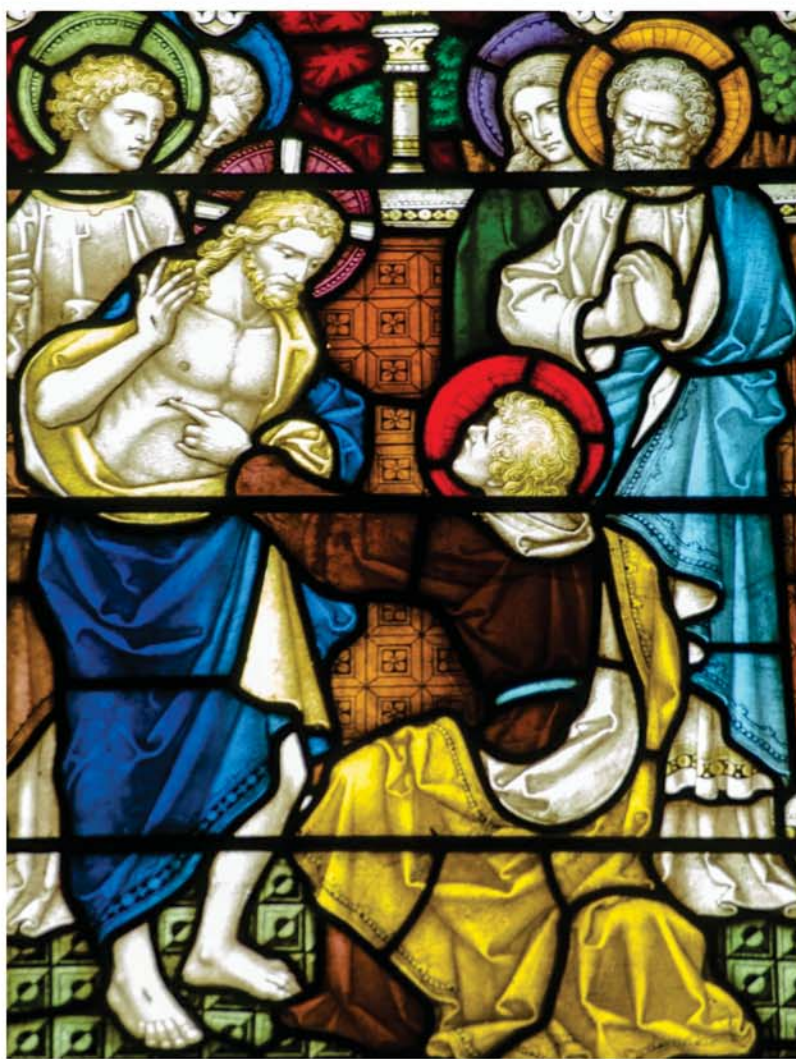

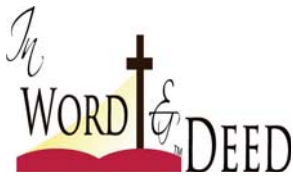

Certain moments in life are “oh, no” moments. We suddenly realize that what we thought was absolutely true turns out not to be. Facts and new information forces us to re-think our position and we have to admit to ourselves and to others that we were wrong. Our certainty gives way to truth and we realize our mistake; hence, the ‘oh, no.’

Thomas has an “oh, no” moment. He and the Apostles had been with Jesus throughout His ministry. They were the first witnesses to His work, His words, and His miracles. Yet they were at first very skeptical about His resurrection. When he appeared, Thomas was absent and the others tried to convince him that they had seen Jesus. He doubted their testimony. So when Jesus appears to Thomas, he has an ‘oh, no’ moment. He not only dismisses his doubts, but he also professes his faith.

In the community of the Church, we experience the Risen Lord. In word and sacrament, in prayer and service, we find the assurance of the Lord. Together we join Him in working towards the goal of our faith: eternal life.

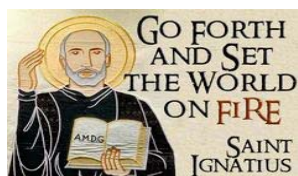

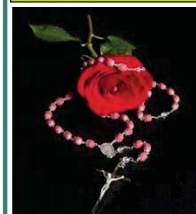
