





The experience of the disciples on the road to Emmaus differs from that of Thomas. He had spent time alone, away from the Apostles and found himself doubting the Resurrection of Jesus. The disciples spent time together, discussing the events of the day as they struggled to understand what had happened. When Jesus joins them, they are open and willing to hear His words and are led to a deeper faith.

Jesus once said that where two or three are gathered in His Name, He is present with them. His Presence leads them to trust and faith as they share their experiences and insights into God's grace and work in their lives. Faith is strengthened when the Church, the Body of Christ, is called together.


