#### THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

'I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I will give is my flesh for the life of the world" John 6:51



In this painting of the Last Supper, which was part of a main altarpiece in Valencia, Spain, the artist highlights the most important and profound truth of Christianity: the centrality of the Paschal Mystery, the heart of which is Christ's body and blood. The artist emphasizes Christ's divinity with the perfect circle reserved for his halo and the wafer (despite the presence of bread on the table). The artist captures the precise moment when Christ initiates the Eucharistic celebration, which the Church declares today as "the source and summit of the Christian life."

## PRECIOUS BLOOD WILL BE OFFERED FOR COMMUNION

Beginning this weekend, the Precious Blood of Jesus will be distributed for holy communion. Following the indication of our Bishop and under the guidance of sanitary authorities, the reception of the Precious Blood doesn't represent any risk to the health of communicants. However, it is not mandatory to receive the Chalice to have full communion.

You can receive the Precious Blood **RIGHT AFTER** consuming the host. **No consecrated Host dipping (intinction)** is allowed to receive the Blood of Jesus. You can also receive only the Blood of Christ.

If you experience any symptoms, we kindly ask you to restrain yourself from receiving the chalice.
