The artwork related to today's gospel comes to us from a German artist who co-founded a group called the *Lukasbund* (Brotherhood of St. Luke – because the evangelist is the patron saint of painters). They were a group of 19<sup>th</sup> century German artists (mostly converts to Catholicism) who sought to reform contemporary painting and drawing by reviving older Renaissance techniques. The example above is part of a book that sought to bring higher quality art to commercial bibles at that time. It is an engraving made after an original drawing by Friedrich Overbeck so that it could be mass produced for an affordable price. Here we see Christ reprimanding the Pharisees by gesturing toward them with his right hand; effectively silencing them. Five of the apostles are shown with John kneeling in the foreground (because he is typically the apostle without a beard). Curiously, the Pharisees, despite the rather strong rebuke they are receiving, seem to be pondering Christ's words rather than pushing back and arguing with him. Perhaps we should be doing same?

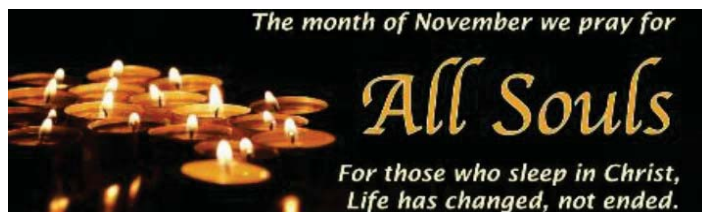

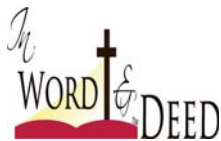

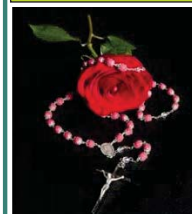
