"A man named John was sent from God. He came for testimony, to testify to the light, so that all might believe through him. He was not the light, but came to testify to the light. And this is the testimony of John." Jn. 1: 6-8



Today's painting might seem like an innocuous portrait of the "Holy Family," but it is loaded with theological content. The gospel today speaks of St. John the Baptist preparing the way for the Lord, Jesus Christ. This painting reminds us that John the Baptist is Jesus's cousin by the inclusion of Mary's sister Elizabeth who is on the far left in a yellow mantle (which typically symbolizes revealed truth). She supports the infant Baptist, who is shown lifting an apple up to the infant Jesus, who reaches down to receive the fruit. This gesture symbolizes, among other things, the passing of the 'narrative' of salvation from the Old to the New Testament since John the Baptist is considered the transition figure between the two. We cannot ignore the fact that it is an apple that is passed between them - here signifying the redemption and salvation of the fall of humanity caused by Adam and Eve in the garden. Christ is shown here in his role as fulfilling the scriptures. Also note the shadowed figure of Joseph on the right in his role as (literally and figuratively) supporting the family; he also holds a compass signifying his trade as a carpenter.

"Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing. Give thanks in all circumstances, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Je-Stewardship sus." (1 Thessalonians 5:16 - 18) This WAY OF LIVING scripture reading sums up Steward-

ship. "Rejoice always" means place your trust in God; He will provide all that you need. "Pray constantly" means prayer should be a running conversation with God throughout the whole day, every day. "Give thanks in all circumstances" means even in bad situations, thank God. Suffering a little bit helps build empathy for others in similar situations and shows our dependence on God

The "O" Antiphons are seven short verses sung before the Magnificat during Evening Prayer of the Church on the seven days before the vigil of Christmas. They each begin with the exclamation "O".
