"Peace be with you." Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and see my hands, and bring your hand and put it into my side, and do not be unbelieving, but believe." Thomas answered and said to him, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to him, "Have you come to believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed."

Although the story of "Doubting Thomas" has been illustrated by artists since the 6<sup>th</sup> century, this one by the Italian Baroque artist known as 'Caravaggio' is the most famous. Here we have Christ literally and figuratively leading Thomas out of the dark shadows (representing doubt) into the light (representing faith). Illuminating the scene from Christ's side of the painting, Caravaggio composes the figures in a tight group: Christ's calm, serene expression counterposes the apostles' anxious faces. Thomas' wrinkled up forehead exaggerates his astonishment as Christ leads his hand to his side wound. Also of note is that Caravaggio indicates the shape of a cross through the vertical alignment of two apostles' heads in the center of the composition, and suggests the horizontal bar of the cross through the arrangement of their arms (from Christ's elbow to Thomas' elbow) reminding us that this entire scene is only possible because Christ conquered death through the cross.

This year, 85 is celebrating its

130<sup>th</sup> year of consecutive service and support to St. Luke's Parish. 2023 was a record year as the Council donated \$25,000 to charitable organizations, and invested nearly 5,000 volunteer hours running programs benefiting the Parish, the Westborough Community, our Brother Knights, and their families.

Over the last 3 years, our membership has grown by 32%: 30 new Knights have joined the Council, and an additional 10 veteran Knights have transferred into the Council. Our membership now stands at 149 Knights. Cultural Diversity is increasing with 19% of our new Knights coming from Latino, South Asian, and African American Cultures. The Council is also becoming younger, as most new Knights are in the 30 to 55 age group.

During the weekend of April 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup>, the Council will hold its annual recruiting program; and the process has been streamlined. Following each Mass, Knight Ambassadors will be distributing Council 85 Information Packets in the vestibule. Each packet recaps the Council's recent achievements, lists the programs and services the Council provides, and describes the benefits a Council 85 Knight can expect to receive. Additionally, directions are included on how to apply on-line to become a Knight at Council 85.
