I am the good shepherd, and I know mine and mine know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I will lay down my life for the sheep. Jn. 10: 14-15



The theme from today's gospel is captured here in one of the earliest works of Christian sculpture (and Christian art) that exists. Found together with a set of other famous marble sculptures (The Jonah Marbles) in an ancient Roman site in what is now Turkey, this sculpture stands 19 ½ inches high and depicts what appears to be a young shepherd carrying one of his sheep. However, since it was carved in the 3rd century, before Christianity became legal—and during a time when Christians were routinely persecuted—this theme has a double meaning. On the one hand it can be read as evoking the idea of a peaceful pastoral setting one might associate with Roman ideas of the afterlife, but it can also be read as having Christian theological significance. Since it was found with a trove of other statues associated with early Christianity there is little doubt the sculpture refers to the passage highlighted in today's gospel referring to Jesus Christ as the Good Shepherd. One common feature of Early Christian art is that Christ is often shown as a beardless youth in classical Roman dress further complicating the subject matter and meaning.

On Saturday, April 6th the second graders participated in Bread Day to complete their preparation for First Communion! Students and parents had a fun morning learning all about the Eucharist






