There was a wedding at Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. Jesus and his disciples were also invited to the wedding. When the wine ran short, the mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine." And Jesus said to her, "Woman, how does your concern affect me? My hour has not yet come." His mother said to the servers, "Do whatever he tells you." John 2:1-5



This incredible work depicts today's gospel through a variety of 'mixed-media' materials. Created in 'New Spain' (Mexico), it reveals several influences ranging from Spanish Catholic art traditions to trends in the global art trade at the time, primarily the trade between Spain's colonies and Japan. The resulting image appears similar to Japanese lacquer work, but the technique here is known as an *enconchados*, which means it is composed of shells (encrusted inlaid mother-of-pearl shells) and oil paint glued to a wooden panel. The result is a luminous, colorful dynamic piece with a three-dimensional quality. The dark background with thin gold lines and patterns contrasts with the figures in the foreground, namely the Virgin Mary and Christ whose presence is highlighted by the corner of the wedding table pointing directly at us. We see Mary urging her son to aid the wedding hosts who have run out of wine. To the right, servants rush to transfer the new wine into decanters. On the far left the 'headwaiter' tastes the new wine with a look of astonishment on his face. The clothing of Christ and Mary is exquisitely rendered in translucent mother of pearl and gold paint, which highlights the transcendental nature of this divine event: Christ's first miracle.


A favorite breakfast place in our town brags about its choice of twenty different jellies and jams for your morning toast, 8 different types of coffee
