Today's painting of the Transfiguration of Christ on Mount Tabor, as described in today's gospel, depicts Christ shining with divine light, looking upward, alongside Moses (left – holding the stone tablets of the 10 Commandments) and Elijah (right). The artist's innovative use of light and color creates a luminous, cascading effect that characterizes the dynamic Baroque style influenced by painters like Rubens and Bernini.




