

Jesus entered a village where a woman whose name was Martha welcomed him. She had a sister named Mary who sat beside the Lord at his feet listening to him speak. Luke 10:38-39



Our painting depicts today's gospel scene of Christ visiting Martha and Mary. Siemiradzki shows Christ teaching Mary at his feet in a sunlit, outdoor terraced-style setting, while Martha stands holding a jug in the left background, occupied with household duties and looking at her sister with concern. The work contrasts spiritual contemplation with worldly care, echoing the biblical message. Having never visited the Middle East, Siemiradzki's setting reflects a romanticized, idealized vision typical of 19th-century academic art rather than historical accuracy drawn from firsthand observation.

FEAST OF ST. JAMES THE GREATER FRIDAY, JULY 25



On July 25, the Catholic Church will be celebrating the feast day of St. James the Greater. St. James was a fisherman and the brother of John. Peter was his partner. When they were called to become Apostles of Jesus, they left everything to do so. St. James the

Greater is the patron saint of laborers and Spain.

There were two Apostles named James. James the Greater is the older of the two. He was also called "The Son of Thunder". James, John and Peter were honored to be the only Apostles present at the Transfiguration. They were also present in the Garden of Gethsemane while Jesus prayed before His death.

Tradition tells us he evangelized in Spain after the crucifixion for nine years. St. James the Greater was the first Apostle to be martyred. In the year 44, King Herod Agrippa killed him with a sword during the early persecutions of the Church.

Since July 2024, St. Luke's sign project team has worked collaboratively with a sign vendor to deliver a beautiful sign for the front of our beloved church.

This spring, the project experienced a series of unforeseen setbacks in the availability and delivery of quality materials and workmanship. The

two brick pillars built in April did not meet quality expectations of the St. Luke's sign team. The vendor deconstructed the pillar last week and will rebuild them at their own cost. The total project cost to St. Luke's has not changed from the budget and any cost overruns are and will be covered by the vendor.


