Painted when Rembrandt was just 21, this work presents an elderly man examining a coin by candlelight, surrounded by books, papers, and gold scales. Here, the young artist experiments with dramatic *chiaroscuro* (striking contrasts of light and shadow in paint). Just as the candle is temporary so is the man's earth-bound wealth. Like the rich man in the parable, Rembrandt presents to us a man that has neglected his spiritual life in favor of the relentless pursuit of worldly wealth.



### IN WORD AND DEED



The class was having a discussion about what really matters in life and where we find a sense of value and success. As the students grappled with the notion of ma-

Jesus tells the parable of the rich man who places his trust in his material wealth. But His disciples must place their hope and treasure, their value and worth in the Lord. It is not worth the effort to focus time, energy and attention on things that will not last, if we lose the chance to build wealth that lasts forever. Material things are important, but not at the cost of our values, morals and ideals. As the popular proverb says, you can't take it with you!


