

Today's painting is by the same artist featured two weeks ago, William Holman Hunt, who depicted the persistent neighbor knocking at midnight with unexpected guests. Here, in The Light of the World, Hunt presents us with a beautiful figure of Christ in an allegorical setting as a visitor bearing a radiant lantern in the dark of night. Christ knocks on a door overgrown with vegetation with no exterior handle representing the stubborn individual who continues to resist Christ's invitation.
