


SAINT LUKE THE EVANGELIST PARISH

Today's painting portrays an early British family sheltering a missionary within their rough riverside hut, while outside a mob of pagan Celts pursues his companion, urged on by a Druid. Within the hut, a red cross painted on a stone signals the family's Christian faith, emphasizing the contrast between the new belief of Christianity and old enduring pagan traditions. The painting, like today's gospel, reminds us that discipleship carries a cost and that the Christian path is not an easy one.

We would be delighted to meet them!


