

Today's image evokes the gospel story of Lazarus, the poor beggar. He lies near death at the foot of the stairs of a grand house (depicted in an Egyptian style). Behind its columns, bright colors and faint figures suggest a lively feast, while a servant descends the steps to fetch more wine - seeing but ultimately ignoring the beggar. The joyful celebration continues above, as Lazarus suffers unseen below. This painting stands as a vivid reminder to notice - and respond to - the needs of those around us.



IN WORD AND DEED ~ by James Gaffney



One difficult task that every parent faces is teaching their children that there are consequences to the decisions and choices we make. A young child has a temper tantrum or a teen becomes sullen because a bad choice resulted in the loss of a toy or privilege. Kids will try to bargain their way out, or make all kinds of promises. But when we choose poorly, we suffer greatly. Sometimes the payback is just not

fair.

Jesus teaches His listeners that failing to hear and act on the Word of God has consequences. We are given all the gifts of faith, hope and love that we need to see God's signs, to hear His Word and to love Him and others as the Lord teaches. We can choose to ignore what faith gives us and do nothing, or we can choose to act on faith and do something. Each choice has its own consequences.

When we choose to share our faith, the results can be amazing. People find their mission and gain a sense of purpose. Lives are redirected and hope is restored. The hungry are fed, the sick are visited and the suffering receive comfort. A famous monk once made the comment that he feared many of the world's ills did not come from evil, but rather from the failure to live faith. If that is the case, God help us all.
