Our painting today is from a medieval illuminated Gospel book from 11th century Germany. Specifically, it tells the story of today's gospel of Christ healing ten lepers. The story is separated into two parts. On the left we have a beardless youthful Christ shown with a halo in the act of healing the ten lepers. On the right we can see the artist made it clear that only one, the Samaritan (shown kneeling), returns to thank Christ and is blessed as the others shuffle away to the far right.

There are words in English that can motivate people to greatness, encourage others to give, inspire heroic deeds and satisfy the need for recognition and support. They


touch the core of our being and connect us to each other in unique and powerful ways. They give us strength, determination and a sense of worth. One such word is love. Another is thanks.
