Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time, August 1, 2021

From Fr. Mark

We welcome Dennis Rima here this weekend as he speaks to us about the work of the Clarity Clinic in Dubuque. Thanks to all who help support this ministry helping parents and their children, including those children in the womb of their mothers and those children already born.

In today's passage from the Gospel of John, the crowd challenges Jesus to perform a sign so that they could faith in him. I try to imagine what their tone of voice was as they demanded that Jesus "perform" for them. Jesus stays patient with them, and offers them a teaching about the real heavenly bread, the bread that gives life to the world. Then, I imagine their tone softens, and it seems they really do want what Jesus offers. "Sir, give us this bread always," they besought him. Jesus explained to them: "I myself am the Bread of Life."

I can ask myself, "What tone do I use with Jesus when I am in need?" Am I willing to gratefully accept the gift Jesus offers?
