PASTOR'S CORNER

We live in extraordinary times. On the one hand, violence against Christianity is on the rise. However, more and more people are also returning to or newly embracing the faith! Across the world baptism numbers are up. Here in Alaska I'm hearing that many churches have increased OCIA numbers – and that includes our Parish! Also, we have so many new people here at Holy Family that I'm having a hard time tracking everyone! What a great "problem" to have!!! Are we in the beginning of a revival?!

For years it's seemed as though the Catholic church was in a state of managed decline. However, signs seem to point in the opposite direction in the last few years. The Dominicans had been bucking this trend of "managed decline" for a number of years now – both in our parishioner numbers and in our vocations numbers.



Now, we Dominicans are diving right into the middle of this new reality. We are leading with the Gospel – that is the Rosary! In the Rosary we have a summary of the Good News of salvation! When we share the mysteries of the Rosary, we literally preach the Gospel! The path to heaven is in the mysteries of the Rosary from the Annunciation to the Coronation. When we follow the path of the Rosary, we end up beside our Blessed Mother in heaven as saints!

It's so important for us to know the scriptures – especially the Gospels because they tell us what we need to share with others and also help us grow close to God. Both our own relationship with God and sharing the faith are absolutely essential for Christians. However, after we've meditated on the Gospels and go back to our daily tasks, we can take up the Rosary! When we exercise or when we are in the car, we can keep the Gospel meditation going!

October is the month of the Rosary – and also the month we take up our collection for our youngest Dominicans – true champions of the rosary! Anchorage has consistently supported our Dominicans at a very high level the past 10 years or so, and now you're seeing the fruits of your investments!

Frs. Matthew H, Matthew W, and Columban have had their seminary studies paid for because of your generosity! The Dominicans are investing in Alaska with some of our youngest Priests, and your generosity has helped them get here! THANK YOU!!!

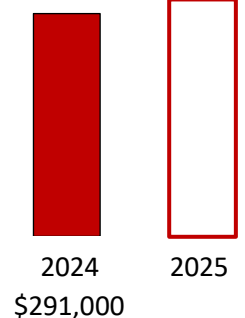
