In our Gospel today, we hear of our Lord cleansing several lepers. However, only one of them returns to give thanks! I'm sure that the others had legit excuses as to why they did not return. Many of them were probably very busy re-establishing ties with their families as lepers would be cut off from all others. They would need a new

would need a new place to live, a job, etc. The scriptures also do not indicate that their failure to return was done out of any sort of malice. However, only one of them returned to give thanks.



I've noticed this in my own life – how many times something great happens to me. I might give thanks to God for a moment or two, but then I usually forget about it and move on to the next thing. This is even true of healings. Sometimes, when I'm sick, I think the whole world is crashing down as I feel miserable. However, when it passes I usually just dive back into the rat race again.

How often I forget my blessings – even though God has showered so many on me!

This is the time of year when many of us can drift into sadness or melancholia. I'm a Californian, so I don't particularly like the different seasons, and I also really love the sun! Also, for me, I'm not really affected by the coldness of Alaska, but the dark and grey can sometimes get to me. If I'm not careful, I'll catch myself wallowing in pity, wishing to be at Lake Tahoe, Yosemite, or Carmel (my three favorite places on earth!) But then I snap out of it when I realize how beautiful and blessed my life is here in Alaska – especially with all of you at Holy Family! I'm forming deep friendships, and I'm growing in holiness as I help others to try and grow in holiness! I'm a lucky Pastor!

As we get closer to thanksgiving, let us focus more on the virtue of gratitude! When we feel down or anxious, let's take a minute or two (it might have to be early in the morning or late at night if we are crazy busy), and maybe even make a list of things that we are blessed with!

Often in times of real stress and tragedy, people still give thanks. In our own country, we know the story of the pilgrims, after the hard times they had in Plymouth, giving thanks. During the Civil War, Abraham Lincoln urged the country to give thanks.

Thank you all for your prayers, friendship, and support for me and for all the Dominicans! I have a lot to be thankful for – especially the opportunity to grow in holiness! *Siempre Adelante*!
