This weekend in addition to All Saints' Day, we celebrate All Souls' Day – those twin days focused on the afterlife. Rejoicing with the souls who are already with God in the church in heaven, and praying for the souls



still yearning to see the face of God in the church in Purgatory. It is a wonderful time to pray for our loved ones who have died – and also to re-calibrate our lives and journeys toward our hoped for goal in heaven!

I truly believe we are a parish of people who want to be saints! However, an essential question to follow this is are we helping others become Saints, too? We are not called to be saints by ourselves. Our own spiritual lives are not meant for us alone. It can never be simply "me and Jesus." Do we help others become saints??

When celebrating All Saints' Day, much like praying the rosary, it puts our final end in mind. In the rosary, all of the mysteries, except for the last, document the life of Christ and the early church.
