PASTOR'S CORNER

When someone comes to confession, he or she is supposed to let the Priest know approximately his or her age and state of life. When I get a single male in his 20s or 30s, I often ask if he's discerned his vocation. Many of them say no. After encouraging them to discern marriage or priesthood, I usually tell them "you can start by being a father now – because one of the differences between marriage and the priesthood is how you are called to be a father!"

If a man says he wants to be a Priest, I ask if he has the desire to be a husband and father. If the answer is no, then I tell him that he wouldn't make a good Priest either!



Today we celebrate both Fathers' Day and Trinity Sunday. A human family ought to be a reflection of the Trinity. In the Trinity we have three distinct persons, yet united in unbreakable bonds of love. Also, the Trinity's love is not self-focused. God is the author of all creation, and the Love of the Trinity spills out into this very creation. Analogously, a married couple are two distinct persons united in unbreakable bonds of love. The love of husband and wife should not merely be self-focused but overflow into creation through their children. It's not a one to one correspondence, but this analogy can help us see the depths of God's love and how He is reflected in the human family.

A father is fundamental to a family! We, of course, know heroic single mothers who do an incredible job raising their children! However, every person still yearns for a father! Priests supply spiritual fatherhood which can be very helpful to those who feel fatherless or abandoned by their biological fathers.

Therefore men, let us be those fathers whom God has called us to be! Let us be fathers who are courageous! It takes a lot of guts to speak up for the truth these days – especially in a society which doesn't value absolute Truth but only acknowledges “your truth and my truth.”

We also need to be fathers who know how to sacrifice. In our age of “me first” and “you do something for you,” a sacrificing father can set a very different example. A father, who loves his bride and children enough to forget self-centered needs and work always for the other, imitates Christ who willingly accepted the cross for others!

Finally, we need fathers who love God! Too many fathers abdicate their role as spiritual heads of the household and “leave religion to their wives.” How sad it is when we see a woman going to church by herself without her husband! Men, we need to take the lead in religious matters – being ready to lead prayer and get our families to Mass! Let us be fathers who are courageous, fathers who sacrifice, and, above all, fathers who want to be Saints – and want our families to become Saints too! *Siempre Adelante!!!*
