PASTOR'S CORNER

If someone ever asks me how he or she can grow in the spiritual life, my first answer is always “go to daily Mass whenever possible!” There are many ways to grow in our faith and be close to God. However, the most sure path to this encounter for us who have faith is through the Eucharist!

God's love for man is incredible when we think about it. God would leave His holy heaven to become lower than the angels and take on our mortal flesh and blood in Jesus Christ. He humbles Himself even more by going to the Cross for our sins and wickedness. Then, He further humbles Himself by

becoming our food! He gives us this food until the end of time in the sacrament of His body and blood. By our eating and drinking, and our openness to the graces that come from the sacrament, we become more like Him whose flesh we receive!



Christ is also truly present when we read the scriptures, in the person of the Priest, and is present living in you and me! However, I don't genuflect to the Bible. Christ is present in the Eucharist in a different modality! He has a corporeal presence and not only a spiritual presence in the Eucharist. Therefore, it is a special and privileged place to encounter Christ!

The primary way to encounter Christ in the Eucharist is eating and drinking. This is why we should frequently go to Communion. However, we can also extend that experience of encounter with Christ when we come to Eucharistic adoration!

All of us need to spend time in front the Eucharist if at all possible! Some people are called to spend more time in front of the Eucharist such as the contemplative Nuns at Blessed Sacrament Monastery here in Anchorage. However, all of us, no matter what vocation, should make visits if possible and spend some time with our Eucharistic Lord!

Can you spare an hour?

This summer we are trying to expand Eucharistic adoration here at Holy Family. We need that contemplative heart in our parish if our active and evangelical missions are going to succeed! St. Teresa of Calcutta, one of the most active Sisters in the world in her efforts to uphold human dignity in the poorest of the poor, still prayed one hour a day in front of the Blessed Sacrament. She knew that, without this foundation of prayer in front of the Eucharist, her missionary efforts would soon wither.

Our acknowledgement of Jesus Christ as Lord of our lives and those of others is supreme over anything else we can do in this life! There is no better way to encounter Him, to love and adore Him, and to be strengthened in our vocations than through the Eucharist! This Corpus Christi Sunday, let us grow in a greater love for the Eucharist, and if possible, commit ourselves to more Eucharistic adoration – helping to form the next generation of Alaskan Saints!!! *Siempre Adelante!*
