## ST. JOHN THE EVANGELIST (& APOSTLE)

St. John the Apostle, the son of Zebedee and Salome, was one of the 12 Apostles of Jesus. John was called to be an Apostle by our Lord in the first year of His public ministry. He is considered the same person as John the Evangelist, John of Patmos and the Beloved Disciple.

John's older brother was St. James the Great, another of Jesus' 12 Apostles. Jesus referred to the brothers as "sons of thunder." John is believed to be the longest living apostle and the only not to die a martyr's death.

St. John is the patron saint of love, loyalty, friendships, and authors. He is often depicted in art as the author of the Gospel with an eagle, symbolizing "the height he rose to in his gospel"!

## PARISH HEALTH MINISTRY

Genesis 2:7 "then the Lord God formed man of dust from the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living being".

Being able to take a breath of air is necessary for life. There are however, some respiratory conditions that create great difficulty taking in that God given breath. There are two I will be discussing and leaving info about on the bulletin board in the community hall-- ASTHMA and COPD.

"Asthma is a disease that affects your lungs. It is one of the most common long-term diseases of children, but adults can have asthma, too. Asthma causes wheezing, breathlessness, chest tightness, and coughing at night or early in the morning. If you have asthma, you have it all the time, but you will have asthma attacks only when something bothers your lungs." (CDC.gov)

"Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, or COPD, refers to a group of diseases that cause airflow blockage and breathingrelated problems. It includes emphysema and chronic bronchitis. Although there is no cure for COPD, it can be treated." (CDC.gov)

Knowing what signs and symptoms to watch for and getting early treatment along with removing the offending triggers to attacks----allows less loss of school and work time/faster recovery. Please take a few minutes and check out the bulletin board info ----you may know someone or you yourself may have one of these conditions----there may be something new!






