


DONATIONS

ST. JOHN THE EVANGELIST (& APOSTLE)

St. John the Apostle, the son of Zebedee and Salome, was one of the 12 Apostles of Jesus. John was called to be an Apostle by our Lord in the first year of His public ministry. He is considered the same person as John the Evangelist, John of Patmos and the Beloved Disciple.

John's older brother was St. James the Great, another of Jesus' 12 Apostles. Jesus referred to the brothers as "sons of thunder." John is believed to be the longest living apostle and the only not to die a martyr's death.

St. John is the patron saint of love, loyalty, friendships, and authors. He is often depicted in art as the author of the Gospel with an eagle, symbolizing "the height he rose to in his gospel"!

PARISH HEALTH MINISTRY

2 Corinthians 4:16 "So we do not lose heart. Though our outer nature is wasting away, our inner nature is being renewed every day."

Psalm 32:8 "I will instruct you and teach you the way you should go; I will counsel you with my eye upon you." Ephesians 4:23 "Let the Spirit change your way of thinking."


