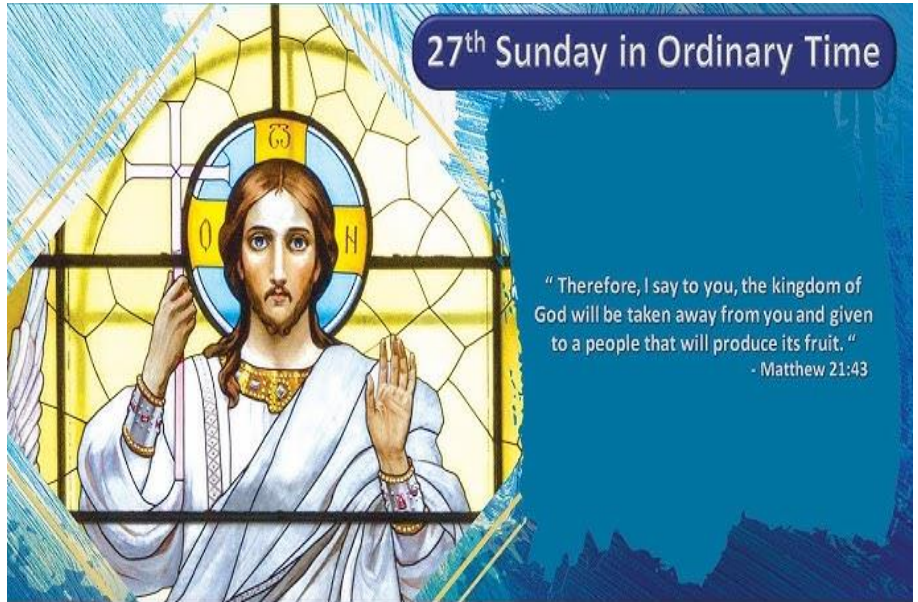

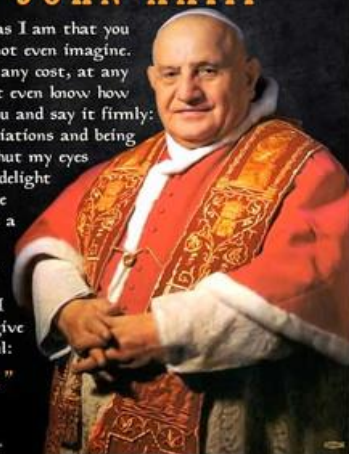


POPE SAINT JOHN XXIII

"To suffer and be despised for you."

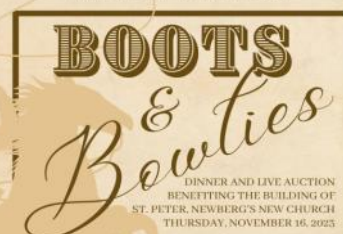

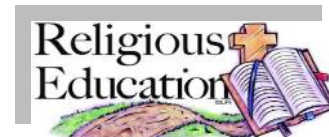
