### A Call for Prayer

Appealing for peace in the Holy Land, Pope Francis expresses concern for the humanitarian situation in Gaza, calling on all parties to lay down their weapons and all Christians to pray and fast on October 27th for peace.

"War solves no problems," he said. "It only sows death and destruction, increases hatred, multiplies revenge. War erases the future, it erases the future." The Holy Father went on to urge all believers to "take one side only: that of peace. But not with words," he continued, "with prayer and with total dedication."

Pope Francis invites everyone to a day of prayer, fasting, and penance for peace on Friday, October 27.
