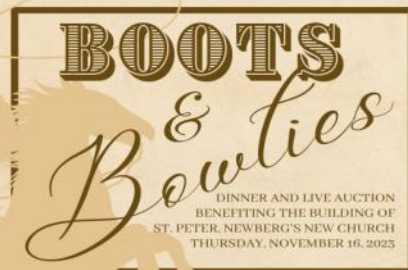

7. **PLAN YOUR MEMORIAL SERVICE** (This is What Your Parish Can Assist You With).

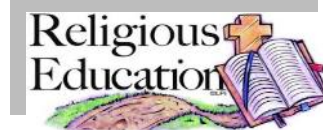
