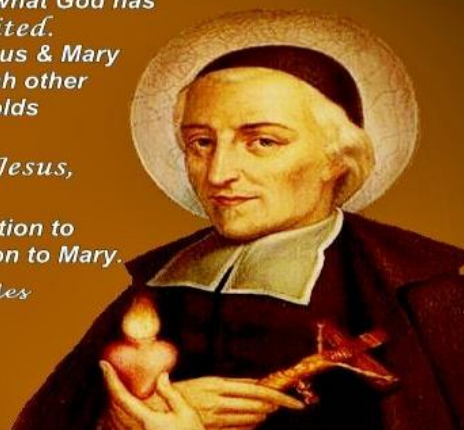
Feast of St. Bartholomew *August 24*
