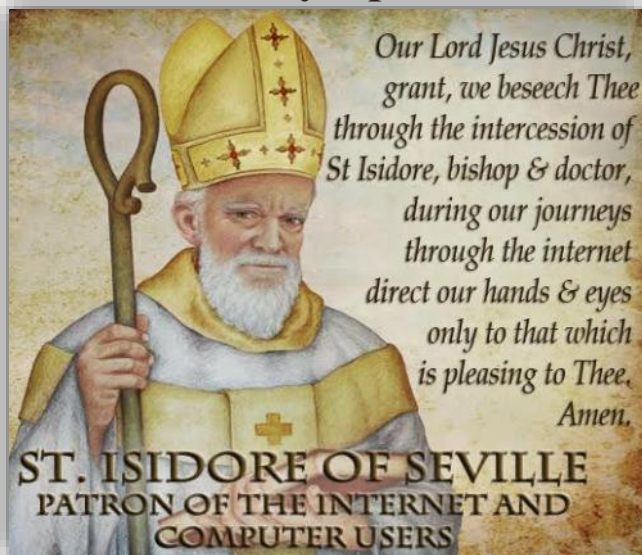

Sign up will be at the Entrance.

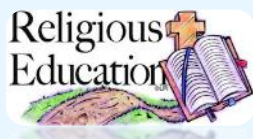
Lent Confessions Schedule

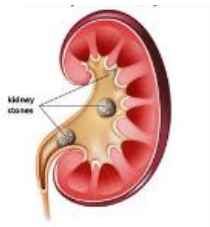
