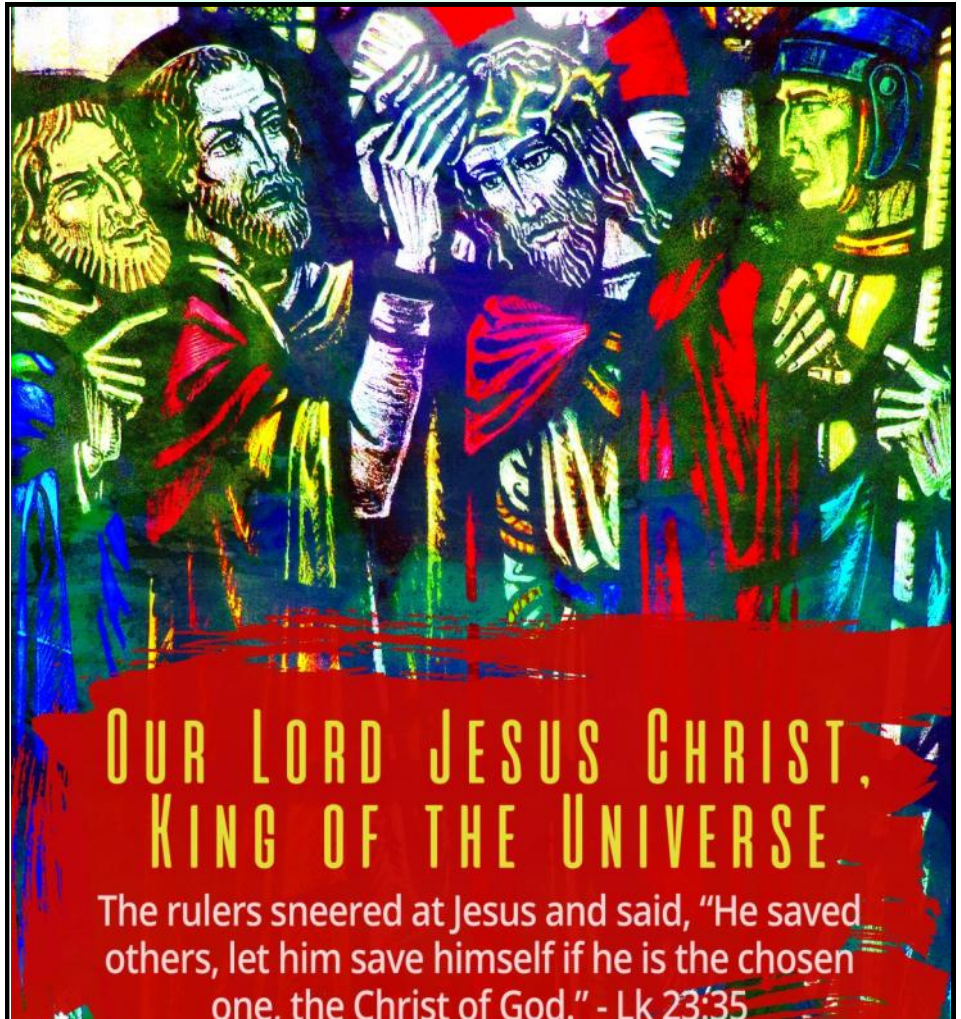

A time to give birth, and a time to die; a time to plant, and a time to uproot the plant.

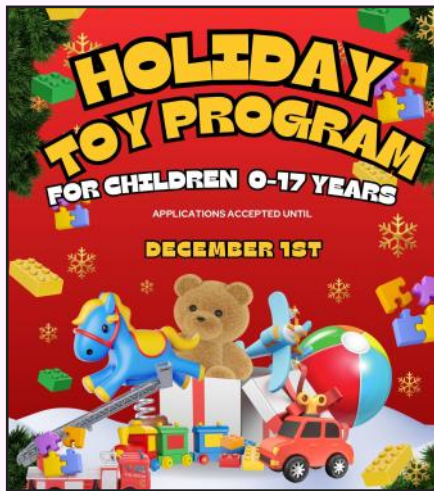
A time to kill, and a time to heal; a time to tear down, and a time to build.
