We have been discovering the growth of the early Church throughout this season of Easter, first through the apostolic preaching before the authorities and the multitudes and, today, through the need for assistance in the selection of the first deacons, described in the Book of Acts. In the second reading, Saint Peter affirms that we are a chosen people, living stones that surround Christ, the cornerstone. Through our baptism, we belong to Christ, who has called us out of darkness and into his marvelous light. These affirmations from both readings seem at first to contrast the questions that Thomas asks the risen Lord in the Gospel: "Master, we do not know where you are going; how can we know the way?" Christ's response is clear and affirming: "I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me" (John 14:5-6). The Gospel text seems to prepare us for the upcoming solemnity of the Ascension. Much of this biblical material may be used reflective dialogue among the parish community, especially for youth groups. Some of these questions may be

used: What do these words mean for Christ, "way," "truth," and "life"? What did Jesus mean by "No one comes to the Father except through me"?

**Hemos** ido descubriendo el crecimiento de la Iglesia primitiva a lo largo de este tiempo de Pascua, primero a través de la predicación apostólica ante las autoridades y las multitudes y, hoy, a través de la necesidad de ayuda en la selección de los primeros diáconos, descritos en el libro de los Hechos. En la segunda lectura, san Pedro afirma que somos un pueblo



elegido, piedras vivas que rodean a Cristo, la piedra angular. A través de nuestro bautismo, pertenecemos a Cristo, quien nos ha llamado de las tinieblas a su luz maravillosa. Estas afirmaciones de ambas lecturas parecen al principio contrastar las preguntas que Tomás hace al Señor resucitado en el Evangelio: "Maestro, no sabemos a dónde vas; ¿Cómo podemos conocer el camino?" La respuesta de Cristo es clara y afirmativa: "Yo soy el camino, la verdad y la vida. Nadie viene al Padre sino por mí" (Juan 14:5-6). El texto evangélico parece prepararnos para la próxima solemnidad de la Ascensión. Gran parte de este material bíblico puede ser utilizado para el diálogo reflexivo entre la comunidad parroquial, especialmente para los grupos de jóvenes. Se pueden usar algunas de estas preguntas: ¿Qué significan estas palabras para Cristo, "camino", "verdad" y "vida"? ¿Qué quiso decir Jesús con "Nadie viene al Padre sino por mí"?


