# FROM THE DESK OF FR. KURT

"You duped me O Lord and I let myself be duped."

The words of the prophet Jeremiah are a heart felt prayer to God which expresses his true feelings of pain and anguish. God does not mind if we tell him like it is. What

he does mind is hiding from the truth of human suffering. Whether we like it or not, the Christian life comes with the cross and we will never be able to avoid it.

In the Gospel this Sunday, Saint Peter tries to convince Jesus that the cross is not necessary and he gets rebuked for doing so. We do not have to like the crosses that are given to us in our life but we have to accept them as a part of the price paid for our redemption. It is ok for us to let God know that we are suffering and to ask for his support during our supplication. We must however come to believe that Jesus will never abandon us but will support us during our times of suffering and bring us to the glory of His Resurrection.
