

New Child and Working Family Tax Credits Available

Even if you are not required to file Minnesota income tax returns, you can still file to claim valuable stat tax benefits. The Working Family Credit and Child Tax Credits deliver tax relief to individuals whose income is below a certain level. Both credits are refundable,

meaning you can receive a refund even if you do not owe tax.

- What is the Child Tax Credit? A credit available to Minnesotans who have children under 18. By filing a MN tax return, you may qualify for \$1,750 per child with not limit on the number of children.
- What is the Working Family Credit?
 A credit available to Minnesotans who earn income during the year. The maximum Working Family Credit is \$350 if your earned income is \$8,750 or more & can increase by
 - ⇒ \$350 for no qualifying child
 - ⇒ \$1,275 for one qualifying child, age 18 or older
 - ⇒ \$2,450 for two qualifying children, age 18 or older
- ⇒ \$2,850 for three or more qualifying children, age 18 or older Both credits are phased out if your income is over\$35,000 for those whose filing status is Married Filing Jointly or over \$29, 500 for other filers.
- How do I claim these credits? File an individual earned income tax return.
