PENETENTIAL RITE	Recited		Priest does penitential right: <i>Lord have mercy, Christ have mercy, Lord have mercy.</i>
GLORY TO GOD <i>Mass of Christ the Savior</i>	Glory to God BB 9-1-5 Father sprinkles the congregation while the Gloria is sung.		Immediately following the Penitential Right.
RESPONSORIAL PSALM	Psalm 98: All the Ends of the Earth BB 5-5-5		Cantor will announce immediately following the 1 st reading
GOSPEL ACCLAMATION	Alleluia! Give the Glory BB 9-0-0 Refrain X2		Following the 2 nd reading - start the Gospel acclamation when the Priest stands and says – “let us rise for the gospel”.
PREPARATION OF THE GIFTS	This is the Day BB 8-0-8		Follows the prayers of the faithful read by the Lector with a short prayer by the priest.
HOLY, HOLY <i>Mass of Christ the Savior</i>	BB 9-1-8		When Father says: “... <i>with the choirs of heaven, we cry out to your majesty on earth and without end we acclaim...</i> ” (or something similar)
MEMORIAL ACCLAMATION <i>Mass of Christ the Savior</i>	We Proclaim Your Death BB 9-1-9		Father will genuflect after raising the cup and say: “ <i>The mystery of faith:</i> ”
AMEN <i>Mass of Christ the Savior</i>	BB 9-2-2		Father will raise the cup and sing: “ <i>Through Him with Him, and in Him, O God, almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honor is yours, for ever and ever:</i> ”
LAMB OF GOD <i>Mass of Christ the Savior</i>	BB 9-2-3		Immediately following the “Sign of Peace”
COMMUNION 1	Ye Sons and Daughters BB 1-7-6		Start as soon as the cantor and accompanist are back from communion.
COMMUNION 2	Come to the River BB 6-5-2		Immediately following the 1 st communion hymn if needed. Plan to wrap up as Father sits following communion.
CLOSING	The Strife is O’er BB 5-7-7		Priest will give the final blessing. Cantor will announce the closing hymn.
