

Dispensation for St. Patrick's Day: The feast of St. Patrick is March 17, which falls on a Friday during Lent. Therefore, Bishop Joe S. Vásquez has decreed that on Friday, March 17, 2023, all Catholics of the Diocese of Austin, no matter where they may be, and all other Catholics actually present in the Diocese on that day, are, by his authority, dispensed from the obligation to abstain from meat (Code of Canon Law, can. 87). While it is not required that anyone make use of this dispensation, those who do wish to make use of it are encouraged to abstain from meat on some other day as part of their penitential practices during Lent.

La fiesta de San Patricio es el 17 de marzo, que este año cae en viernes durante la Cuaresma. Por lo tanto, el obispo Joe S. Vásquez, por la autoridad que le concede el Código de Derecho Canónico, ha decretado que el viernes 17 de marzo de 2023, todos los católicos de la Diócesis de Austin, sin importar dónde se encuentren, y todos los demás católicos presentes en la Diócesis ese día, dispensa de la obligación de abstenerse de comer carne (Código de Derecho Canónico, can. 87). Si bien, no se requiere que nadie haga uso de esta dispensación, se anima a aquellos que deseen hacer uso de ella a abstenerse de comer carne algún otro día como parte de sus prácticas penitenciales durante la Cuaresma.

THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT



If we were to ask ourselves, what is the most important visible thing God created in the universe? I say visible, because air is not visible, but it is absolutely necessary; without air, life on the planet could not exist. Now, the most important visible thing God created in the universe is, without doubt, water. Plant and animal life can not exist without water. In the 1st reading from Exodus, the people of Israel were traveling through the desert, and because they had no water, they were close to dying, along with their animals. But God miraculously saved them. God instructed Moses to strike with his staff the rock in front of them at the foot of Mt. Horeb. And water came gushing out in abundance. In today's Gospel Jesus promised the Samaritan woman a special water that gives life, eternal life. Jesus told her: "The water I shall give will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life." And the Samaritan woman was eager to receive this kind of water. Who would not want to receive this water? Who would not want to receive eternal life? Of course, Jesus is speaking about the sanctifying water of baptism, which conveys the Holy Spirit. However, this saving water of baptism comes with various caveats; namely renouncing sin and professing faith in Jesus Christ (and in his Church). As St. Peter told the crowd of Jews at the very first baptism: "Repent, and be baptized, everyone of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit" (Acts 2, 38). During the Lent we pray for our catechumens who will receive the saving water of baptism in the Easter vigil. And we must pray a lot for ourselves, already baptized, that we may be strong in our baptismal commitment and truly live our baptismal consecration. Let us be a living light in the world of darkness!

Si nos preguntamos, ¿Qué sería la cosa visible mas importante que Dios ha creado en el universo? Digo visible, porque el aire es invisible, pero absolutamente necesario; sin el aire no se puede tener vida en el planeta. Ahora, la cosa visible mas importante que Dios ha creado, sin duda, es el agua. La vida de planta y animal no puede existir sin agua. En la 1^a lectura del Éxodo, el Pueblo de Israel estaba caminando por el desierto, y debido a la falta de agua, estaban cerca de la muerte, junto con sus animales. Pero Dios milagrosamente los salvó. Dios mandó a Moisés que pegara con su bastón a la roca que estaba en frente de ellos a pie del Monte Horeb. Y brotó de ella agua en abundancia. En el Evangelio de hoy Jesús prometió a la mujer Samaritana agua especial que da vida, la vida eterna. Jesús le dijo: "El agua que yo le daré se convertirá en un manantial capaz de dar la vida eterna." Y la mujer Samaritana tuvo muchas ganas de recibir esta agua. ¿Quién no tendrá gusto de recibir esta agua? ¿Quién no tendrá gusto de recibir la vida eterna? Claro, Jesús está hablando del agua santificante del bautismo, que comunica al Espíritu Santo. Sin embargo, esta agua santificante del bautismo viene con condiciones, es decir, renuncia al pecado y tener fe en Jesucristo (y en su Iglesia). Es como San Pedro dijo a la muchedumbre de judíos en el primer bautismo: "Conviértanse, y háganse bautizar cada uno de ustedes en el nombre de Jesucristo, para sus pecados sean perdonados. Y Dios les dará el Espíritu Santo" (He.2, 38). Durante la cuaresma pedimos por nuestros catecúmenos que recibirán el agua salvífica de bautismo en la Vigilia Pascual. ¡Y debemos pedir mucho por nosotros, para que seamos fuertes en nuestro compromiso bautismal y vivamos de veras nuestra consagración bautismal!
