From The Archives

Fr. B. J Bekkers was appointed pastor of St. Patrick in 1899 and he is remembered for the founding of the first Knights of Columbus Council in Mississippi (Council 802) in 1903. He was a native of Holland and had previously served at the Indian Mission for the Choctaws for 15 years. He was instrumental in growing the Catholic School for boys and girls during his time in Meridian.


#IGiveCatholic will be on Giving


