

Continuing our remembrance of Fr. James Wendell SVD who served Mount St. Joseph parish (1910-1920). Other highlights of his tenure included celebrating the mission's first wedding (December 1913), construction of the Convent for the Sixters of Mt. St. Joseph for the Sisters of Mt. St. Joseph that was completed in June 1914 and the addition of the high school that graduated 16 student in its first class.


