The church traces its roots back to 1910 when Bishop Thomas Heslin of the Natchez Diocese asked Father Aloysius Heick SVD to establish a mission for African-Americans in Meridian. Property was purchased on 18th Avenue between 19th and 20th Streets. The original name of the Mission was Mount St. Joseph and a church building was constructed that same year.
